MINUTES SUMNER COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SEPTEMBER 18, 2017

The Board of County Commissioners of Sumner County, Tennessee met in regular session on Monday, September 18, 2017, in the Commission Chambers of the Sumner County Administration Building in Gallatin, Tennessee at 7:00 p.m. Present and presiding was the Chairman Scott Langford. Also present were the County Clerk Bill Kemp, County Executive Anthony Holt and County Law Director Leah Dennen and the following Commissioners to wit:

Having a duly constituted quorum, the meeting was opened in due process by Sheriff Sonny Weatherford. Chairman Langford noted that with twenty-three members seated, a simple majority would be by thirteen votes; and that matters requiring a two-thirds vote would be by sixteen votes during this session. Commissioner Paul Decker was not present for the meeting.

The Invocation was led by Bishop A. Michael Clark of the Flame of Fire Institution International in Gallatin and Glasgow, KY.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by the County Clerk, Bill Kemp.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Commissioner Akins moved, and was duly seconded by Commissioner Graves, to adopt the agenda. The Commission approved the agenda by unanimous voice vote of the body.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes for the meeting of this body held on August 28, 2017, and recorded in the office of the Clerk, Bill Kemp, were approved by voice vote after Commissioner Pomeroy made the motion, seconded by Commissioner Kemp.

RECOGNITION OF THE PUBLIC

Chairman Langford opened the floor to allow the public to speak concerning any matter on the agenda. With no one else wishing to speak, recognition of the public was closed.

REPORT OF THE CHAIR

Chairman Langford recognized Commissioner Moe Taylor who praised the quick response of the Highway and Sheriff's Departments for doing their part to avert an accident due to a large pothole on Gains Hill Road.

Chairman Langford announced a chili supper and bake sale at the Castalian Springs Community Center on October 28.

Commissioner LeMarbre moved, seconded by Commissioner Foster, the nomination of Scott Langford as Chairman of the County Commission and Leslie Schell as Chairman Pro Tem to serve for the 2017-2018 year. The motion carried unanimously by the body.

Chairman Langford noted that the Veterans Service Officer's report was provided for information only.

Chairman Langford recognized General Sessions Judge Mike Carter and Commissioner Krueger who read the following resolution into the record:

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING SEPTEMBER 2017 AS NATIONAL RECOVERY MONTH

WHEREAS, September is National Recovery Month and Sumner County wishes to recognize the importance of facilitating mental well-being and recovery for individuals with addiction issues so they can become responsible and contributing members of the community; and

WHEREAS, National Recovery Month promotes the societal benefits of prevention, treatment, and recovery for mental and substance use disorders, celebrates people in recovery, praises the contributions of treatment and service providers, and promotes the message that recovery in all its forms is possible; and

WHEREAS, National Recovery Month presents the opportunity to educate the community on issues related to mental health and substance abuse and celebrate health improvements and achievements made by individuals in recovery.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sumner County Board of County Commissioners meeting in regular session on this the 18th day of September, 2017, that this body hereby recognizes and celebrates National Recovery Month and encourages all community members to participate in activities that promote health, recovery, and mental wellbeing, acknowledging that behavioral health is essential to overall health; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is to be spread on the minutes of this body, and the Clerk is to furnish a copy of this resolution to the Recovery Court of Sumner County.

Upon motion of Commissioner Krueger, seconded by Commissioner Ring, the Commission voted to approve the resolution recognizing National Recovery Month. Chairman Langford recognized Judge Carter who accepted the resolution on behalf of those working in the field of addiction and recovery.

Chairman Langford recognized Jimmy Johnston of Forward Sumner who made a presentation on economic and community development through land use, financial feasibility and accessibility. Mr. Johnston discussed the transportation corridors in Sumner County, including the completion of State Route 109, the Portland Bypass and expansion of the northeast transportation corridor (State Route 386). Mr. Johnston yielded the floor to Mike Agee who contracts with Forward Sumner to promote Sumner County's interest through the legislative process. Mr. Agee said the expansion of State Route 386 has moved to a priority by TDOT and was included in the Improve Act passed by the General Assembly. He said Phase 1 of the State Route 386 project funding was part of the law.

Chairman Langford reported that the public hearing and vote on the Special Provision Governing Industrial Zoning Districts will be heard in October 16 Commission meeting.
