MINUTES SUMNER COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MARCH 19, 2018

The Board of County Commissioners of Sumner County, Tennessee met in regular session on Monday, March 19, 2018, in the Commission Chambers of the Sumner County Administration Building in Gallatin, Tennessee at 7:00 p.m. Present and presiding was the Chairman Scott Langford. Also present were the County Clerk Bill Kemp, County Executive Anthony Holt and County Law Director Leah Dennen and the following Commissioners to wit:

Having a duly constituted quorum, the meeting was opened in due process by Sheriff Sonny Weatherford. Chairman Langford noted that with twenty members seated, a simple majority would be by thirteen votes; and that matters requiring a two-thirds vote would be by sixteen votes during this session. Commissioners Paul R. Goode, Mike Akins, Bob Pospisil and Kevin Pomeroy were absent from the meeting.

The Invocation was led by Pastor Andrew Ervin, First United Methodist Church, 149 West Main Street in Gallatin.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by the County Clerk, Bill Kemp.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

County Law Director Leah Dennen requested the addition of a Beer Board hearing. She explained that the Beer Board lacked a quorum to consider the business before the Board. The State law allows for the full Commission to act as the Beer Board. Upon motion of Commissioner Ring, seconded by Commissioner Bill Taylor, the Commission vote to add the beer application to the agenda under Report of Chairman as #5. Commissioner Moe Taylor moved, and was duly seconded by Commissioner Schell, to adopt the agenda with the addition. The Commission approved the agenda as amended by unanimous voice vote of the body.

WHEREAS, it is agreed that this local government will retain a sufficient amount to insure prompt payment of allowed claims without deduction for administrative costs or service charge and that the balance of funds will be deposited in this local government's general fund.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sumner County Board of Commissioners requests the State Treasurer to pay the unclaimed balance of funds to it in accordance with the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated Section 66-29-121.
