Chairman Harris brought the regular scheduled meeting of the General Operations Committee to order with an invocation by Comm. Klein on Monday, July 6, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. in the Sumner County Administration Building. Chairman Harris declared a quorum present to conduct business.

3. Approval of Agenda.

County Law Eric Sitler requested the addition of a lease agreement for Vanderbilt LifeFlight.

Comm. Rogers moved, seconded Comm. Jones, to approve to add the item to the agenda. The motion carried unanimously. Chairman Harris added as item 10d.

Comm. Rogers moved, seconded by Comm. Wynne, to approve the agenda as amended. The motion carried unanimously.

4. Approval of the Minutes.

a. June 1, 2026

Comm. Wynne moved, seconded by Comm. Rogers, to approve the minutes from June 1, 2026. The motion carried unanimously.

Comm. Schmit noted some of the pages were too light to read that were attached to the agenda.

5. Recognition of the Public.

Jim Latimer, 1578 Latimer Lane, Hendersonville, addressed the committee regarding the William and Martha Brown House. He requested an update on the status of the architectural proposal and encouraged the county to continue moving

the restoration project forward. He also requested that the property around the house be mowed, noting that overgrown vegetation has made the site difficult to access. Mr. Latimer emphasized the historical significance of the property and stated that preserving and restoring the house would provide valuable educational opportunities for future generations, particularly students attending the nearby schools.

Chairman Harris explained anyone else wishing to speak on the Brown House could speak at the end of the meeting since it is not an agenda item.

6. Report of Chairman.

No report.

7. Report of Finance Director.

a. Capital Projects and ARPA Projects Update

Scott Shamrock, Projects and Grant Specialist reported:

- Westmoreland water line projects have been completed, with all final change orders finalized. The projects were completed under budget by approximately \$105,000, and closeout with the State is scheduled to begin the following week.
- Two of the Portland water line projects have been completed, with one project entering the state closeout process the following week. A meeting was scheduled with Oak Hill Tank to resolve the remaining final change order between the City of Portland and the contractor. He noted that the matter is between those parties and does not involve the county. Remaining grant funds will be applied to the Oak Hill Water project to restore previously removed project elements, extending that project through the end of August.
- Courtroom 5C is complete except for the installation of furniture.
- Renovations for the Recovery Court have begun, with demolition substantially complete and framing and electrical work underway.
- He reported that the limited demolition phase of the William and Martha Brown House has been completed and all associated costs have been paid. Following a walkthrough with the project architect, the architectural proposal was reviewed by legal counsel, the purchase order process was completed, and the contract has been forwarded to the County Mayor's Office.

Handout with updates attached.

Mr. Shamrock requested committee approval to allow the City of Gallatin, through its engineering consultant, Kimley-Horn, to use the county's existing courthouse survey for the design and construction of the raised courthouse crosswalk project previously approved by the county.

Comm. Klein moved, seconded by Comm. Jones, to give permission to the City of Gallatin to use the survey. The motion carried unanimously.

Comm. Genung asked who is paying to re-do the courthouse steps. Mr. Shamrock explained the County is paying because damage is outside of the warranty period.

Committee members discussed concerns regarding the replacement of the courthouse steps, including warranty coverage, project costs, and potential responsibility of the original contractor.

After discussion, Comm. Wynne moved, seconded by Comm. Rogers, to get facts and report back next month. The motion carried unanimously.

The Committee continues discussion about the following projects:

- Hendersonville Health Department construction schedule.
- State Route 258 roadway project and potential impacts to school traffic.
- Brown House property maintenance, including mowing.
- Status of the Hollows Phase II project.
- Westmoreland EMS construction progress.

8. Report of the County Mayor

County Mayor John Isbell mentioned a phone call from a descendant of the Brown family expressing concerns about the park's establishment. He also reported that, after reviewing the Brown House project and the language contained in William Brown's will, he requested the architect merge the existing house restoration proposal with the original park plan to establish the William and Martha Brown Park within the existing budget before executing the architectural contract.

Mayor Isbell announced details of the July 8, 2026, America 250 celebration.

a. Cottontown Flood Mitigation Plan Implementation.

Mayor Isbell explained that deed revisions were being completed prior to closing.

After discussion, Comm. Jones moved, seconded by Comm. Klein, to suspend the rules to have open discussion. The Committee voted (4-3-0) to approve. Comm. Harris, Rogers and Wynne voted against.

Committee members engaged in an extended discussion regarding the Brown House project, including:

- The scope of the William and Martha Brown Park.
- Interpretation of the will and codicil.
- Whether restoration of the house or park development should be prioritized.
- Ongoing delays and project direction.

After discussion, Comm. Wynn moved, seconded by Comm. Rogers, to bring the meeting back in session. The Committee voted (4-3-0) to resume session. Comm. Genung, Jones & Klein voted against the motion.

Comm. Jones moved to direct Mayor Isbell to sign the contract as is and move forward with the house. Law Director Eric Sitler advised that execution of contracts falls within the County Mayor's executive authority, and no action was taken.

Recognition of the Public Non-Agenda Items.

Gina Mansfield of 113 Luna Lane, Hendersonville addressed the committee regarding the Brown House project, expressed concern over the length of time the property has remained unrestored and urged the county to honor William Brown's wishes by restoring and maintaining the historic home and providing regular public updates.

Mike McClard of 102 Tioga Trail, Hendersonville addressed the committee regarding the Brown House, expressed frustration with continued delays and encouraged the county to proceed with restoration of the historic property.

Diane Stinson of 1011 Lynndale agreed with the previous speakers and criticized the political delays.

11. Adjournment. Upon motion of Comm. Wynne and seconded by Comm. Rogers, the Committee adjourned at 7:26 p.m.

LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS LEASE AGREEMENT ("Lease") is made and entered into as of _____, 20____ ("Effective Date"), by and between **Sumner County, Tennessee**, having its principal place of business at 355 N. Belvedere Drive, Gallatin, Tennessee 37066 ("Landlord"), and **Vanderbilt University Medical Center**, a Tennessee nonprofit corporation ("Tenant") (with the "Landlord" and "Tenant" constituting the "Parties" and each, a "Party").

WHEREAS, Landlord currently owns land located at 255 Airport Road in Gallatin, Tennessee, upon which is located the County's EMS headquarters building (the "Building"); and

WHEREAS, Landlord desires to lease to Tenant, and Tenant desires to lease from Landlord, a portion of the land and a portion of the Building, for the purpose of conducting Tenant's air ambulance business.

NOW THEREFORE, Landlord and Tenant, for and in consideration of the rents, covenants and mutual agreements hereinafter contained, the receipt and adequacy of which is acknowledged, agree as follows:

1. **Leased Premises.** Landlord hereby leases to Tenant, and Tenant hereby rents from Landlord, the following Premises (collectively, the "Premises"):

a. **Land.** A parcel of land consisting of approximately one (1) acre (the "Land"), as more particularly shown on the map attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and incorporated by reference herein.

b. **Storage Space.** Approximately 121 square feet of storage space located within the Building to be used for mechanic and/or medical supply storage (the "Storage Space").

2. **Term.** The initial term of this Lease shall be for one (1) year ("Initial Term"), commencing on the Effective Date. Thereafter, this Lease will automatically renew for additional subsequent one (1) year terms (each, a "Renewal Term" and together with the Initial Term, the "Term"), unless either Party gives notice to the other of its intention not to renew at least ninety (90) days prior to the expiration of the then-current Term.

3. **Use.** Tenant's use and occupancy of the Premises shall be for the purpose of operating an air ambulance service and uses which are necessary for such operation and which are not excluded by this Lease. Tenant shall not commit an act or omission on the Premises which would be in violation of any statute, regulation or ordinance of any governmental body, quasi-governmental or regulatory body having jurisdiction over the Premises or the activities conducted thereon.

4. **Rent and Payment Terms.**

a. **Rent.** Tenant shall pay rent to Landlord in the amount of \$1.00 per year for the use of the Premises ("Rent"). Such Rent shall be inclusive of any and all applicable federal, state and local taxes for which Landlord may be liable as a result of this Lease.

b. **Payment Terms.** All Rent payments shall be sent by check to Landlord at the following address: Sumner County, Tennessee, 355 N. Belvedere Drive, Gallatin, Tennessee 37066. Rent shall be paid on the Effective Date and on each yearly anniversary thereof. The Parties represent that in entering into this Lease, they have bargained at arm's length, that the Rent is set at a fair market value taking into

account the geographic location and facts and circumstances of the market and that this Lease is entered into in furtherance of the purpose operating an air ambulance service.

5. Utilities.

a. **Land.** Tenant shall be responsible for the payment of all fees associated with use of water, gas, electricity, sewer/septic, telephone, cable/internet and any other public utilities furnished to the Land. In the event that a certain public utility is necessary but not available on the Land, Tenant shall furnish, at Tenant's cost, said utility and all utilities reasonably necessary for Tenant's use of the Land.

b. **Storage Space.** Landlord shall be responsible for the payment of all fees associated with the use of the gas and electricity, and any other public utilities furnished to the Storage Space, the cost of which is included in Tenant's Rent payment.

6. Improvements.

a. **Tenant Improvements.** Landlord and Tenant acknowledge and agree that the following improvements are currently located on the Land and shall remain located on the Land during the Term for Tenant's use in furtherance of Tenant's air ambulance business (collectively, the "Tenant Improvements"), including without limitation the following: (1) a modular building to be used as crew quarters, (2) a modular or Conex building to be used as a maintenance office; (3) a helipad, (4) a fuel truck or other fuel facility; and (5) an aircraft hangar.

Prior to the making of any alterations, installations or additions to the Premises (the "Alterations"), Tenant shall submit detailed plans and specifications of such Alterations to Landlord for written approval, which approval may be withheld in Landlord's reasonable discretion. If approved, Tenant shall obtain all required permits, FAA approvals, TDOT approvals, zoning approvals, and code approvals for the approved Alterations at Tenant's sole expense. All work shall be performed in a good and workmanlike manner and in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.

b. **Removal and Restoration by Tenant.** All alterations and improvements shall remain Tenant's property for the Term. Except for items used primarily in the conduct of Tenant's business and commonly considered "trade fixtures," all alterations and improvements (except for the modular or CONEX buildings which Tenant may remove upon termination or expiration of this Lease) shall immediately upon the termination or expiration of this Lease become Landlord's property.

7. Repairs and Maintenance.

a. **Improvements.** Tenant, at its own cost and expense, shall maintain and make necessary repairs to the Tenant Improvements constructed on the Land.

b. **Storage Space.** Landlord, at its own cost and expense, shall maintain and make necessary repairs to the Storage Space.

8. Landlord's Access.

a. **Storage Space.** Landlord, its employees and agents shall have access to the Storage Space at reasonable times to inspect, repair, make alterations, or make improvements. Landlord must provide Tenant with at least twenty-four (24) hours' notice prior to entry, except in emergencies, in which case Landlord shall provide Tenant with as much notice as possible prior to entry.

b. **Helipad.** In the event of a natural disaster or other emergency situation in which a third-party helicopter requires access to the County's Emergency Operations Center or other County facility located within the Building or in close proximity to the Land, Landlord shall notify Tenant of same and Tenant shall temporarily relocate its helicopter to allow access by such third-party helicopter to Tenant's helipad on the Land.

9. **Common Areas.** Tenant shall have the right, during the term of this Lease, to use in common with Landlord and each Party's employees, and invitees, all walks, drives, and parking, within and around the Land and Storage Space for access to the Land and the Storage Space. All common areas shall be subject to the control and management of Landlord.

10. **Warranties of Title and Quiet Enjoyment.** Landlord warrants that it has full right to make this Lease subject to the terms of this Lease. Tenant shall have quiet and peaceable possession of the Premises during the Term as against the acts of any parties claiming title to, or a right to possession of, the Premises.

11. **Assignment and Subletting.** Landlord's rights to assign this Lease are and shall remain unqualified. No assignment by Landlord shall release Landlord of any of its obligations under this Lease for any time prior to the date of assignment. Tenant shall not assign this Lease or sublet the Premises, whether by voluntary act, operation of law or otherwise, without the prior written consent of Landlord, which shall not be unreasonably withheld; provided, however, that Tenant may, without the prior consent of the Landlord, assign all of its rights under this Lease to (i) a parent, subsidiary, or affiliate, (ii) a purchaser of all or substantially all assets related to this Lease, or (iii) a third party participating in a merger, acquisition, sale of assets or other corporate reorganization in which Tenant is participating. Any permitted assignee shall assume all obligations of its assignor under this Lease.

12. **Fire or Other Casualty.** If the Premises is destroyed or rendered untenable for Tenant's accustomed use by fire or other casualty, this Lease shall terminate immediately, and any prepayment of Rent shall be refunded pro rata to Tenant by Landlord. If the Premises is damaged or rendered partially untenable for Tenant's accustomed use by fire or other casualty, and if the Premises can be repaired within ninety (90) days from the date of such casualty, Landlord, at its option, shall repair the Premises to substantially the same condition as immediately prior to such casualty. If Landlord chooses to repair the Premises, Landlord shall provide thirty (30) days written notice to Tenant of its intent to repair. From the date of such casualty until the Premises are so repaired and restored, the Rent payments shall abate in such proportion as the part of the Premises so damaged or untenable bears to the total Premises. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if the damaged portion of the Premises cannot be repaired within ninety (90) days of such casualty, or if said damage materially interferes with Tenant's use of the remainder of the Premises, then either Landlord or Tenant may terminate this Lease and any prepayment of Rent shall be refunded pro rata to Tenant by Landlord. Landlord shall not be obligated to repair and restore if such casualty is caused in whole or in part by the negligence of Tenant, its agents or employees.

13. **Rules and Regulations.** Landlord may, from time to time, impose reasonable rules and regulations regarding the Premises. Tenant, its employees, agents, invitees and licensees shall comply with all such rules and regulations for which it has been provided written notice, so long as Tenant is given reasonable prior written notice of such rules and regulations.

14. **Insurance.**

a. **Tenant's Obligations.** Tenant, at its own cost and expense, shall maintain in effect during the whole of the Term:

i. **Aviation Commercial General Liability Insurance:** Tenant shall ensure that Aviation Commercial General Liability Insurance is maintained by the aircraft operator, Metro Aviation, through a reputable insurance carrier with limits of not less than Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury, death, and property damage. Such policy shall:

- (a) name Sumner County, Tennessee as an additional insured;
- (b) be primary and non-contributory;
- (c) include contractual liability coverage;
- (d) include products/completed operations coverage;
- (e) include war risk coverage if commercially available; and
- (f) be issued by insurers rated A- or better by A.M. Best.

ii. **Property Insurance:** on Tenant's contents located at the Premises.

iii. **Workers' Compensation Insurance:** for Tenant's employees, as required by law, at all times. Tenant agrees to ensure agents, contractors, invitees, licensees, or anyone for whose safety Tenant is responsible, is appropriately covered by Tenant's workers' compensation insurance or said individual's employer's workers' compensation insurance as required by law. Tenant shall provide certificates of insurance to Landlord annually and upon renewal. All insurance policies shall provide that coverage may not be canceled, materially modified, or allowed to lapse without at least thirty (30) days' prior written notice to Landlord.

b. **Landlord's Obligations.** Landlord, at its own cost and expense, shall maintain in effect during the whole Term:

i. **Commercial General Liability Insurance:** against claims for property damage and bodily injury, including death in such form and subject to such deductions and exceptions as Landlord may determine in an amount not less than \$5 million per occurrence. Landlord agrees those insurance proceeds that may or may not be available to Tenant in the event Landlord is found to be liable for property damage or bodily injury do not limit Tenant's right of recovery from Landlord.

ii. **Property Insurance:** written on an ISO special causes of loss form for cover on the Premises, except foundations, on a replacement cost basis, subject to such deductions and exceptions as the Landlord may determine. Such insurance will be in a form or forms normally in use from time to time for buildings and improvements of a similar nature similarly situated.

iii. **Workers' Compensation Insurance:** for Landlord's employees, as required by law, at all times. Landlord agrees to ensure agents, contractors, invitees, licensees or anyone for whose safety Landlord is responsible for is appropriately covered by Landlord's workers' compensation insurance or said individual's employer's workers' compensation insurance as required by law.

c. **General Requirements.** All required insurance shall be placed with a reputable insurance company. The Parties shall provide to each other evidence of all required insurance upon reasonable request following the Effective Date. All insurance policies shall require the insurer to provide Landlord with at

least thirty (30) days prior written notice of cancellation, nonrenewal, or material reduction in coverage. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, Landlord agrees that Tenant may provide such insurance through an actuarially-sound program of self-insurance.

15. Indemnification. Tenant shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Landlord from and against any and all claims, lawsuits, liabilities, damages, costs and expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys fees, court costs and litigation expenses) arising or resulting from: (i) Tenant's use of the Premises during the Term; (ii) any negligent activities or operations conducted on or about the Premises by Tenant or any of its owners, directors, officers, employees, agents, or representatives; (iii) the use, generation, handling, storage, disposal or release of any Hazardous Substances on or about the Premises by Tenant or any of its agents, employees, contractors, subtenants, or representatives; or (iv) any default under this Lease by Tenant.

"Hazardous Substances" means all hazardous or toxic substances, materials, wastes, pollutants and contaminants that are listed, defined or regulated under applicable laws pertaining to health, safety or the environment, including, but not limited to, medical waste, polychlorinated biphenyl, asbestos, radon, urea formaldehyde, petroleum products and petroleum derived constituents (e.g. gasoline, diesel fuel, oil and hydrocarbons).

Tenant's obligations under this Section shall survive expiration or termination of this Lease.

16. Environmental Compliance:

Tenant shall be solely responsible for the investigation, remediation, cleanup, monitoring, and restoration costs arising from environmental conditions to the extent such environmental condition is caused by the Tenant's use or operation of the Premises. Tenant's obligations under this paragraph shall not apply to: (i) any environmental conditions existing at the Premises prior to the Effective Date; (ii) any conditions caused or contributed to by Landlord, its employees, agents, or contractors, or any third party not under Tenant's control; or (iii) any conditions caused by the migration of contaminants from adjacent or neighboring properties. Landlord shall provide Tenant with all environmental reports, assessments, and studies in Landlord's possession relating to the Premises prior to execution of this Lease to the extent such items are in Landlord's possession.

Tenant shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local environmental laws, regulations, ordinances, and permit requirements related to Hazardous Substances. Tenant shall not cause or permit the release, discharge, spill, storage, or disposal of Hazardous Substances except in strict compliance with applicable law and ordinary aviation operations.

Tenant shall immediately notify Landlord of:

- (a) any environmental condition that may affect the Premises of which Tenant becomes aware;
- (b) any fuel spill or release of a Hazardous Substance; or
- (c) any notice of violation from a governmental agency.

Upon termination of the Lease, Tenant shall remove all fuel tanks installed by Tenant, any Hazardous Substances and any contaminated materials introduced by Tenant to the Premises, and Tenant shall restore affected areas to a commercially reasonable condition.

17. Holding Over. In the event Tenant remains in possession of the Premises beyond the Term, Landlord may take legal action to remove Tenant. If Landlord accepts a Rent payment for a period of time

beyond the Term, or otherwise acknowledges the tenancy, Tenant shall be deemed a Tenant from month-to-month, and shall pay Rent at the rate established by this Lease. Any month-to-month tenancy is subject to the conditions, provisions, and obligations of this Lease.

18. Default by Tenant.

a. **Events of Default.** The following are events of default under and a breach of this Lease:

i. Any failure by Tenant to pay any undisputed Rent due hereunder, after ten (10) business days written notice to Tenant of any non-received payment;

ii. Any failure of Tenant to perform pursuant to the Lease for more than thirty (30) days after written notice from Landlord of such failure, provided, however, such failure shall not constitute an event of default if such failure is not susceptible of being cured within thirty (30) days and Tenant diligently pursues such cure to completion; or

iii. If Tenant shall become insolvent, make an assignment for the benefit of its creditors, file a voluntary bankruptcy proceeding, be subjected to an involuntary bankruptcy proceeding, or if a receiver is appointed for Tenant.

b. **Landlord's Remedies.** In the event that Tenant defaults under the terms of this Lease, Landlord shall have the right to enter and take possession of the Premises and has an affirmative duty to mitigate by re-letting the same upon such terms as Landlord deems prudent, for the account of the Tenant. Tenant shall be liable to Landlord for any Rent due and owing for the remaining portion of the Term, less the net rent received from other parties for the use of said Premises.

19. Default by Landlord. In the event that Landlord defaults under the terms of this Lease, Tenant shall give Landlord written notice specifying the nature of the default and Landlord shall have thirty (30) days after receipt of such notice to cure said default. Any default by Landlord which shall continue uncured shall give Tenant the right to terminate the Lease immediately, in addition to all available rights or remedies in law or in equity.

20. No Partnership, Joint Venture or Principal/Agent Relationship. Nothing in this Lease shall be interpreted as creating a partnership, joint venture, or relationship of principal and agent between the Parties.

21. Cumulative Rights. No right or remedy provided under this Lease is intended to be exclusive of any other right or remedy hereof provided by law or equity. Each right and remedy shall be cumulative and in addition to every other right or remedy provided under this Lease.

22. Subordination. This Lease shall be subordinate to any mortgage, trust, deed or other security instrument now or hereafter placed on the Premises by Landlord. Tenant shall execute and deliver to Landlord all instruments necessary to evidence such subordination.

23. Tenant shall comply with all applicable: FAA regulations, TSA requirements, OSHA standards, environmental laws, fire codes, aviation safety requirements, zoning regulations, and all federal, state, and local laws applicable to Tenant's operations.

24. Liens. Tenant shall not permit any mechanic's lien, materialman's lien, or other encumbrance to attach to the Premises arising from Tenant's activities or improvements.

25. Miscellaneous.

e. **Entire Agreement.** This Lease contains the entire understanding of, and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings between, the Parties with respect to the subject matter of the Lease.

f. **Counterparts; Facsimile or Electronic Signature.** This Lease may be executed in counterparts, all of which shall be considered one and the same instrument and shall become effective when one or more counterparts have been signed by each of the Parties and delivered to the other Party. Any

executed counterpart to this Lease may be delivered by .pdf or other electronic means, and any counterpart so delivered shall constitute an original for all purposes.

g. **Captions, Headings, or Titles.** All captions, headings, or titles in the paragraphs or sections of this Lease are inserted for convenience only and shall not constitute a part of this Lease as a limitation of the scope of the particular paragraphs or sections to which they refer.

h. **Waiver.** Any waiver by any Party of default of any other Party to this Lease shall not affect or impair any right arising from any subsequent default. No custom or practice of the Parties which varies from the terms of this Lease shall be a waiver of any Party's right to demand exact compliance with the terms of this Lease. A waiver will only be effective when signed by the Party against which it is used.

i. **Governing Law and Venue.** This Lease shall be governed, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws in the State of Tennessee.

k. **Sovereign Immunity.** Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a waiver of sovereign immunity, governmental immunity, or any defenses available to Sumner County under Tennessee law.

Chairman Rogers called the regular meeting of the Health and Emergency Services Committee to order with an invocation by Comm. Sullivan on Monday, July 6, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. in the Sumner County Administration Building. A quorum was present.

3. Approval of Agenda.

Without objection, Chairman Rogers added a resolution from the Volunteer Fire Department ad hoc to waive motor vehicle privilege tax for volunteer firefighters as item 14d.

Comm. Harris moved, seconded by Comm. Klein, to approve the agenda as amended. The motion carried unanimously.

4. Approval of the Minutes of May 4, 2026.

Comm. Schmit moved, seconded by Comm. Sullivan, to approve the minutes from May 4, 2026. The motion carried unanimously.

5. Recognition of the Public.

Richard Primrose, 432 Triple Crown Circle, Gallatin, addressed the committee regarding a petition containing nearly 700 signatures requesting greater transparency from the Sheriff's Office concerning the 287(g) agreement. Mr. Primrose expressed frustration that the petition had not been formally addressed and urged the committee to place the matter on a future agenda for discussion.

6. Report of the Chairman.

7. Report of the County Mayor.

Not present.

8. Report of the Sheriff.

9. Report of Emergency Management Agency.

12. Volunteer Fire Department Ad-hoc.

Comm. Harris moved, seconded by Comm. Klein, to suspend the rules to allow Comm. Wynne to give report. The motion carried unanimously.

Comm. Wynne recommended that the HEMS Committee consider adopting TCA 55-4-140 to waive the county's portion of vehicle registration fees for volunteer firefighters. He explained that the waiver would apply to one vehicle per volunteer firefighter and would support recruitment and retention efforts. Comm. Wynne estimated the annual fiscal impact to the county would be less than \$20,000, assuming every eligible firefighter participated. He further noted that adoption of the waiver would require approval by the County Commission with at least 16 affirmative votes at two separate commission meetings.

13. Old Business.

None

14. New Business .

a. Air Ambulance Lease.

Comm. Harris moved, seconded by Comm. Sullivan, to approve. The motion carried unanimously.

b. Rural Health Transformation Fund Ambulance Grant.

Comm. Sullivan moved, seconded by Comm. Harris, to approve. The motion carried unanimously.

c. Health & Safety Standards (from Legislative).

Comm. Klein moved, seconded by Comm. Sullivan, to suspend the rules to allow Marshall Wright to speak to the matter. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Wright clarified that the only portion of the document formally approved by the Board of County Commissioners was the organizational restructuring that transferred all administrative, judicial, and enforcement responsibilities of the former Health and Safety Standards Board to the Board of Construction Appeals, thereby officially dissolving the Health and Safety Standards Board. The remainder of the Health and Safety Standards document, including the proposed modular shipping container regulations, has not been approved by the full commission and remains under review. Following action by the Legislative Committee, the complete document was referred to the Health and Emergency Services Committee for further review, markup, and regulatory alignment, excluding the previously approved board consolidation language and the 200-square-foot threshold. He was also noted that the Legislative Committee amended the proposed plan review and building permit threshold from 160 square feet back to 200 square feet before referring the document to the committee.

Chairman Rogers brought the meeting back in session.

Comm. Klein moved, seconded by Comm. Sullivan, to move to old business for next month. The motion carried unanimously.

d. Waive Motor Vehicle Privilege Tax for VFD.

Comm. Klein moved, seconded by Comm. Sullivan, to approve. The motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Klein stated that he would like a better understanding of the concerns surrounding the 287(g) agreement. He acknowledged that individuals have appeared at multiple meetings requesting transparency and asked the County Attorney to clarify the issue so the commission could better understand the concerns and provide an informed response.

Law Director Eric Sitler explained that questions regarding the administration and day-to-day operation of the 287(g) agreement would be best addressed by Sheriff Craddick. He noted that, as an elected constitutional officer, the sheriff operates independently, and the Law Director does not oversee the Sheriff's Office's operational decisions. Mr. Sitler further stated that the sheriff has explained the agreement and its implementation on multiple occasions and emphasized that the 287(g) program is governed by specific federal requirements, leaving little discretion in its administration. He concluded that any questions regarding the operation of the agreement fall within the sheriff's authority and would be most appropriately answered by Sheriff Craddick.

15. Adjournment. Chairman Rogers declared the meeting adjourned at 5:19 p.m. upon motion by Comm. Harris and duly seconded by Comm. Sullivan.

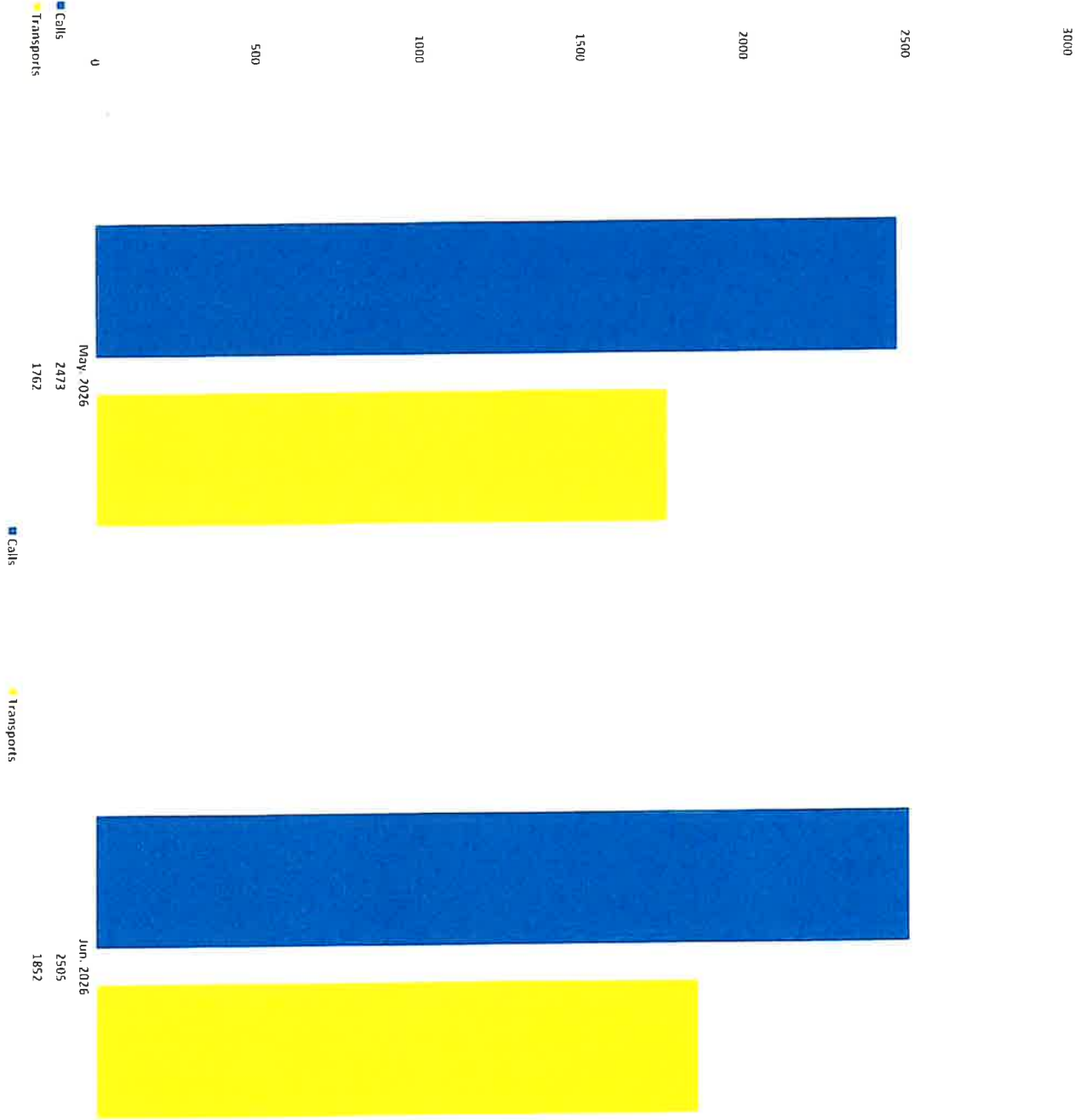

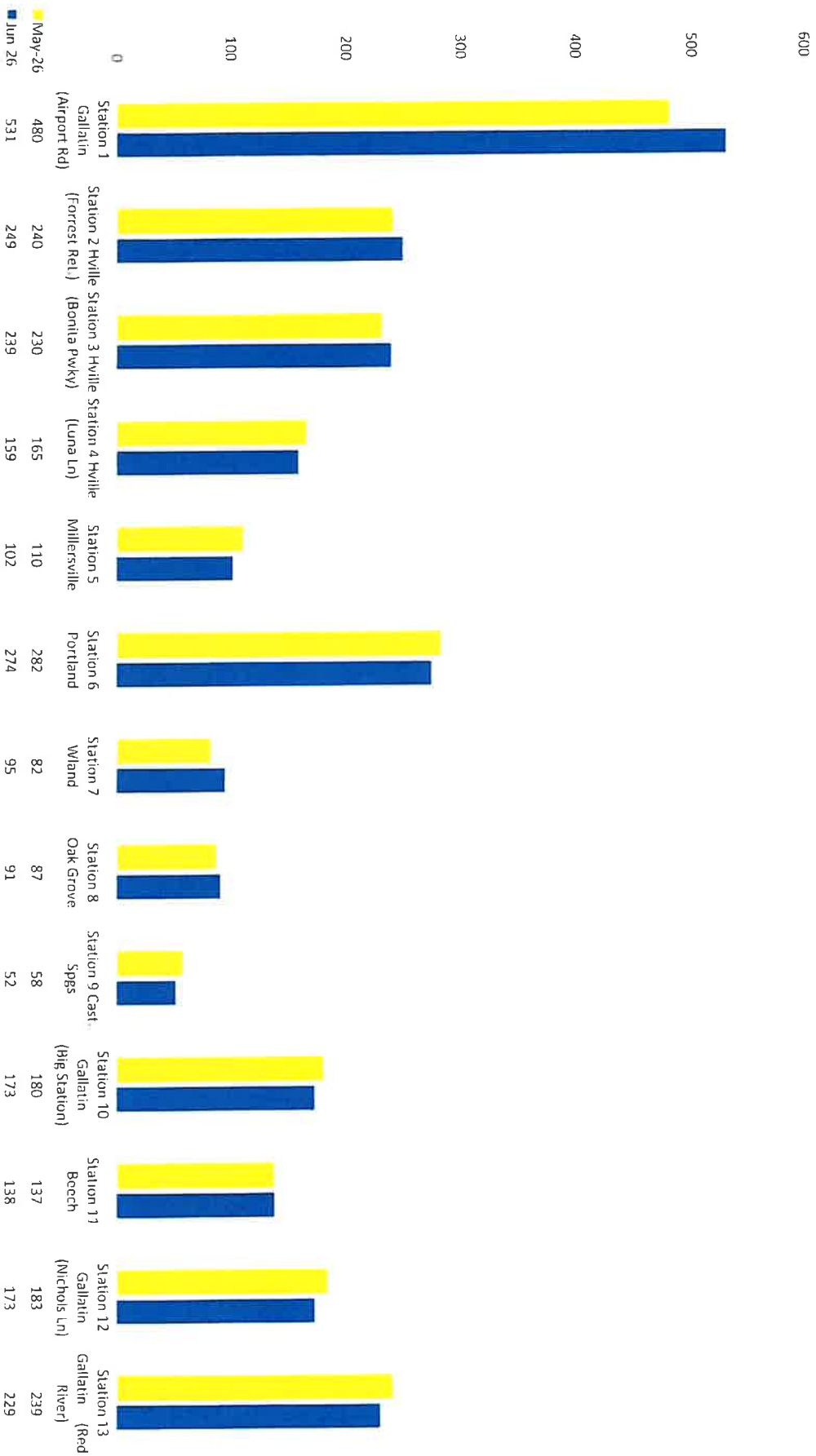

Calls vs. Transports



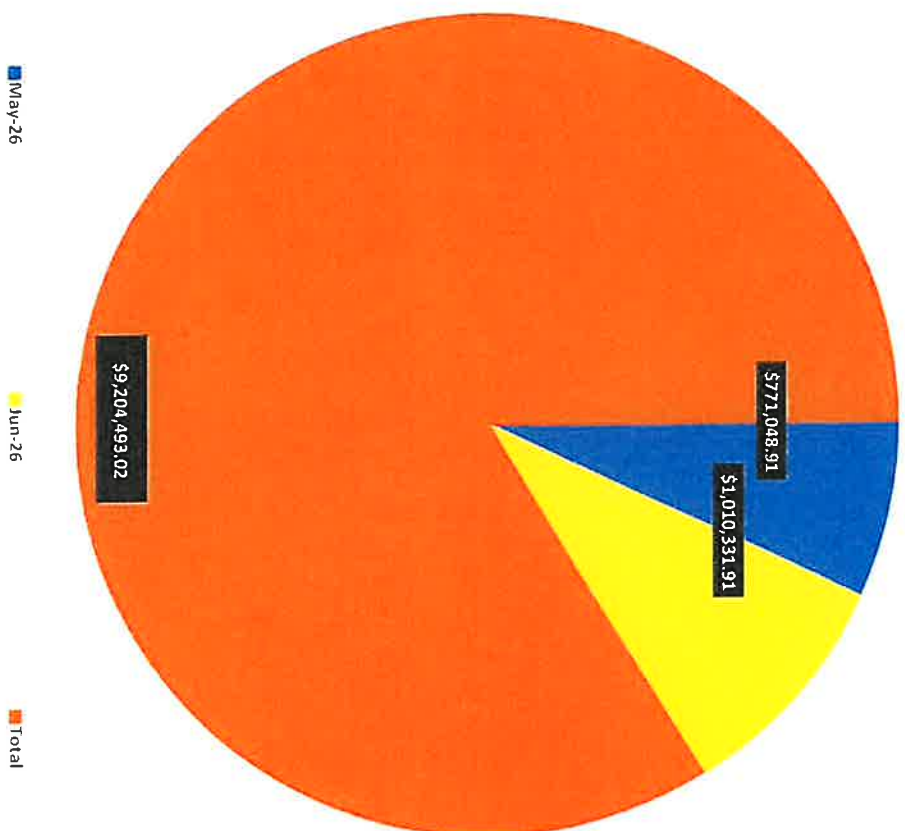
May / June 2026 Call Volume

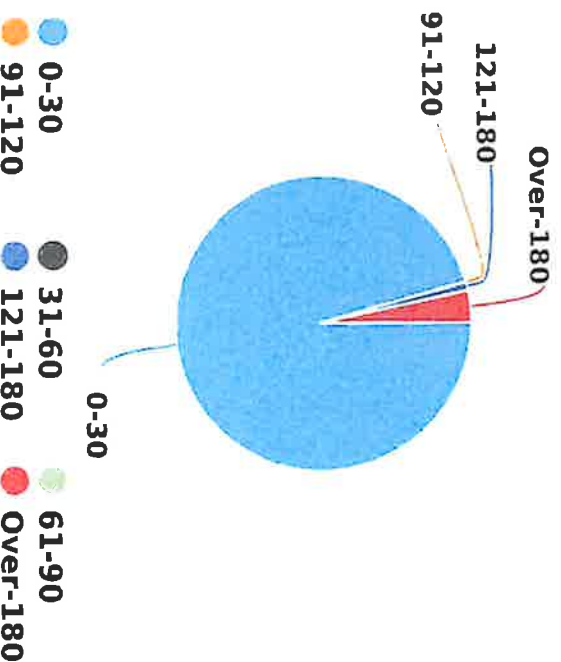
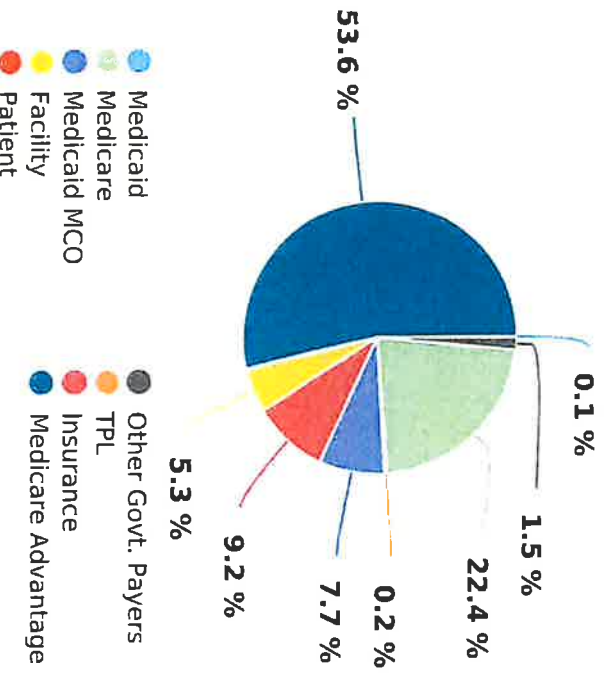

TASA Members,

We participated in a conference call today with the Office of EMS and Department of Health. Answers to many questions are still being sought by the Office through CMS and they plan to have a call with CMS next week to gain more answers and guidance.

The Office will be announcing a webinar for EMS providers that will take place later this month to go over the updates and provide more guidance.

We will share any additional information as we receive it.

Below is a summary of the conference call today.

BOTTOM LINE

Every one of Tennessee's 89 rural counties has \$305,461 on the table for one ambulance and one powerlift system. Nothing else. No stretchers, no monitors, no splitting the money across two trucks. The contract template is identical statewide, and reimbursement only covers documented spend up to the cap. The big open questions all sit with CMS, and the state expects clarified answers at a mid-July webinar.

WHAT'S CONFIRMED

- Scope is one ambulance plus powerlift per rural county. Durable equipment (stretcher, cardiac monitor, supplies) is excluded, and vendors can't bundle it into the reimbursable purchase.

- Counties that don't need a lift can order without one. But excess funds can't be kept. Reimbursement equals actual spend.
- All 89 rural counties are eligible. Municipalities and the six large metros are not.
- The state retains a security interest in the vehicle for the contract term. No sale or trade until the term ends.
- Quarterly transport count and mileage reporting runs through September 30, 2041. The state office will supply most of that data (mileage, transports, permit status, in-service date). No reporting is expected while the truck is on order.

PENDING CMS GUIDANCE

- Prepayment and invoice-based reimbursement. The state hopes to reimburse off invoice before delivery, but CMS hasn't signed off.
- Whether the quote-and-approval-in-advance path is the default or must be requested.
- Whether reimbursement keys to invoice date, payment date, or delivery.
- Application deadline. The meeting referenced both September 30 and end of October 2027. A single authoritative timeline is coming.
- Transfer rules for counties that contract 9-1-1 service to a non-governmental provider. Clarification expected next week.
- Documentation expectations where the county runs EMS with no private provider.

TIMELINE RISK

Manufacturer lead times are running 20 to 30 months, and demand from other states could push that to 36. That directly conflicts with the current grant deadlines, and the department has already raised it with CMS. Anticipated approval turnaround after submission is 30 days, pending CMS confirmation. So the message to members: get quotes moving early. The clock is the biggest threat to this money.

TASA ACTION ITEMS

- Help disseminate grant information to county mayors and finance offices. Initial emails went to Edison contacts and some counties likely never saw them.
- Push members to attend the mid-July webinar once the invite drops.
- Coordinate with county government associations on orientation support. Mayoral turnover hits many counties around September 1, 2026.
- Route all questions through the state point of contact: Brandon Ward, brandon.ward@tn.gov.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUMNER COUNTY, TENNESSEE, ADOPTING A WAIVER OF THE COUNTY MOTOR VEHICLE PRIVILEGE TAX FOR QUALIFYING VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS PURSUANT TO TENNESSEE CODE ANNOTATED §§ 55-4-140 AND 5-8-102

WHEREAS, volunteer firefighters provide an essential public safety service to the residents, businesses, schools, churches, and communities of Sumner County; and

WHEREAS, volunteer firefighters respond to fires, motor vehicle accidents, medical emergencies, hazardous conditions, natural disasters, and other calls for assistance, often placing themselves in harm's way for the benefit of their neighbors; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes that volunteer fire departments are a critical part of Sumner County's emergency response system and provide significant value to the County by strengthening public safety, improving emergency response capacity, and supporting communities throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, Sumner County further recognizes that volunteer firefighters give their time, training, labor, and personal resources without expectation of compensation, and that their service reflects a high level of civic duty, sacrifice, and commitment to the public good; and

WHEREAS, volunteer fire departments across Tennessee and Sumner County continue to face increasing challenges in recruiting and retaining volunteer firefighters due to growing training requirements, increased emergency call volumes, work and family obligations, rising costs, and the overall decline in volunteerism; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that reasonable measures to recognize, support, and retain volunteer firefighters are in the best interest of Sumner County and its residents; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated § 55-4-140 provides that an owner or lessee of a motor vehicle who is a resident of Tennessee, is an active member of a volunteer fire department, and has at least one (1) year of service shall be exempt, at the time of renewal, from the regular state registration fee imposed pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated § 55-4-111 for only one (1) vehicle owned or used by the firefighter, upon certification or sworn statement from the chief of the fire department confirming that the applicant is an active volunteer member and upon compliance with state motor vehicle registration and licensing laws; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated § 55-4-140 further authorizes the legislative body of a county to waive the county motor vehicle tax for motor vehicles receiving the exemption under that section from the registration fee, provided that the waiver is approved in the same manner as the adoption of the motor vehicle tax under Tennessee Code Annotated § 5-8-102; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to express its appreciation for the volunteer firefighters serving Sumner County by adopting the county motor vehicle tax waiver authorized by Tennessee law for qualifying volunteer firefighters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sumner County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session, that:

Section 1. Adoption of Waiver.

Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated §§ 55-4-140 and 5-8-102, the Board of County Commissioners hereby waives the Sumner County motor vehicle privilege tax, commonly referred to as the county wheel tax, for one (1) motor vehicle owned or used by a qualifying volunteer firefighter who receives the state registration fee exemption under Tennessee Code Annotated § 55-4-140.

Section 2. Eligibility.

To qualify for the waiver adopted by this Resolution, the applicant must satisfy all requirements of Tennessee Code Annotated § 55-4-140, including, but not limited to, being a Tennessee resident, being an active member of a volunteer fire department, having at least one (1) year of service, and providing certification or a sworn statement from the chief of the fire department to which the volunteer firefighter is attached confirming that the applicant is an active volunteer member.

Section 3. Limitation to One Vehicle.

The waiver adopted by this Resolution shall apply only to one (1) motor vehicle owned or used by the qualifying volunteer firefighter and shall apply only to a motor vehicle receiving the registration fee exemption authorized under Tennessee Code Annotated § 55-4-140.

Section 4. Annual Verification.

The County Clerk may require such documentation as is necessary and consistent with Tennessee law to verify eligibility for the waiver, including annual certification or sworn statement from the chief of the applicable volunteer fire department confirming the applicant's active volunteer status and length of service.

Section 5. Administration.

The Sumner County Clerk is authorized and directed to administer the waiver adopted by this Resolution in accordance with Tennessee law and applicable procedures of the Tennessee Department of Revenue.

Section 6. Appreciation and Public Purpose.

The Board of County Commissioners finds that this waiver serves a valid public purpose by recognizing the service of volunteer firefighters, supporting recruitment and retention of emergency responders, and strengthening the public safety system serving the residents of Sumner County. The Board further expresses its sincere appreciation to the volunteer firefighters of Sumner County for their dedication, sacrifice, and continued service to the community.

Section 7. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall take effect upon final approval in the manner required by Tennessee Code Annotated §§ 55-4-140 and 5-8-102, the public welfare requiring it.

This past month the VFD adhoc voted to make a recommendation to the HEMS committee to adopt TCA 55-4-140 that would waive the county's portion of vehicle registration fees for volunteer fire fighters. This waiver would be limited to 1 vehicle per fire fighter and would be used by our VFDs for recruitment/retention of volunteers who have 1 or more years of service and are actively volunteering.

The revenue impact to the county is estimated to be under \$20k per year and would require the commission to pass a resolution by 16 votes at 2 separate meetings (TCA 5-8-102).

I am attaching a sample resolution that outlines the intent of the adhoc's recommendation and references the applicable TCAs.
